Students who wish to undertake a more substantial research project have the opportunity to transfer to the Master of Engineering (Advanced)

- Applicants must have completed a UTS recognised bachelor& 039;s degree, or an equivalent or higher qualification, or submitted other evidence of general and professional qualifications that demonstrates potential to pursue graduate studies.
- It is a requirement that the bachelor&
 039;s degree be in engineering and relevant to the applicant&
 039;s proposed major, with no more than 25 per cent of subjects failed.
